



## REGGAE STARS SHAGGY, THE ORIGINAL WAILERS AND ALEX DUNCAN JOIN STELLAR TULALIP RESORT CASINO AMPHITHEATRE "SUMMER CONCERT SERIES"

**TULALIP, Wash. (April 11, 2025)** – The uplifting vibes of reggae under warm sunny skies take center stage during Tulalip Resort Casino's "Summer Concert Series" with the addition of awardwinning artist **Shaggy** (Saturday, August 2, 7 p.m.) joined by **The Original Wailers** and **Alex Duncan.** 

The 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary edition of the series, held at the intimate 3,000-seat outdoor Tulalip Amphitheatre, also features legendary rapper **Ludacris** (Thursday, July 10), Rock & Roll Hall of Fame inductee **Kool & The Gang** with Special Guest **The Commodores** (Friday, July 25) and Grammy-nominated country music star **Chris Young** (Friday, August 8). Showtime for all performances is 7 p.m.

**Shaggy** is a seven-time Grammy Award nominee, winning twice for *Boombastic* (Best Reggae Album) and most recently in 2019, with Sting, for *44/876*. He has scored hits with "It Wasn't Me," "Boombastic," "In the Summertime," "Oh Carolina" and "Angel."

Joining the triple bill are **The Original Wailers**, co-founded by Al Anderson, formerly lead guitarist for the legendary Bob Marley and The Wailers. Inspired by Marley, Peter Tosh and other iconic reggae artists, the Grammy-nominated band is a favorite as it tours the U.S. **Alex Duncan** opens the show with an authentic and unique blend of reggae, dancehall and soca genres. Formerly the lead singer of the Seattle-based band Jumbalassy, he has performed throughout the Northwest to rave reviews.

Popular singles include "What's Your Fantasy," a top 40 hit on the *Billboard Hot 100*, and "Southern Hospitality" (featuring Pharrell), reaching the Top 40.
- Kool & The Gang, with Special Guest The Commodores (\$140/\$135/\$130/\$100; Ticketmaster <a href="https://www.ticketmaster.com/kool-the-gang-with-commodores-tulalip-washington-07-25-2025/event/0F00625AB29252E7">https://www.ticketmaster.com/kool-the-gang-with-commodores-tulalip-washington-07-25-2025/event/0F00625AB29252E7</a> as two hit-making acts perform their greatest hits. Kool & The Gang, perhaps best known for their party-time favorite, "Celebration," has sold more than 70 million albums sold worldwide including R&B classics "Cherish," "Jungle Boogie," "Summer Madness" and "Open Sesame," to name a few. The Commodores, known for their string of major hits in the funk, soul and pop genres, has sold more than 60 million records with hits like "Brick House," "Sail On," "Three Times A Lady," and "Easy." The legendary vocal group's credits include 20 Top Ten singles, 15 Top Ten albums and a Grammy Award.
